<u>Instructions</u>: <u>Lesson 6 (Tables)</u>

In Lesson 6 you will follow the same basic layout as previous lessons. However, for this lesson and all lessons to follow you will need to create a new folder inside your network folder. Title/name this new folder, "Lesson 6". On this web page you will create **7** tables, the new command tags are <TABLE></TABLE>, <TR></TR>, and <TD></TD>, the attributes that we will be using are: WIDTH="a number or percent", BORDER, BGCOLOR, CELLPADDING, CELLSPACING. Only the BGCOLOR and WIDTH attributes will be used with the <TR> & <TD> tags.

Your assignment is to create **7 tables** with **6 or 7 rows and 4 columns**; you are to <u>fill</u> <u>in the table with your class schedule</u>. Each table has the same content; however, each one of the 7 must have different attributes. Follow my example website and duplicate it using your class schedule. As always, save this file in your Network folder and check to make sure it is there before you are done. Remember, to SAVE AS and manually add the .htm file extension, NO SPACES in your Index.htm filename.

<u>HELP</u>: This code is used to start your first table... **It is only for ONE ROW (the 1st row).** You will need to add it 6 more times to have a table with 7 rows. Don't forget to close your table, row and column tags!!!! Otherwise, the table will not work properly...
