

National Park Page Instructions

Create a new folder titled, "*the name of the park that you have chosen*" inside of your network folder. Here is an example of possible folder title, "**Sequoia National Park**".

Next, you will choose a National Park that you do not have much knowledge about and begin to find/save information and photos about that park. **Make sure that you find out what is unique about your chosen Park and what sets apart from other National Parks.**

Now you will begin creating a page about your chosen Park. First, you must have a plan or outline. You are required to have preplanned your site and show this physical evidence with actual storyboards of your site and its layout. Also, you must have at least 5 hyperlinks, 3 of which must be done as follows:

-link (1) will be HOME.

-link (2) will be specific to your park (i.e. coral reefs are a specific portion of Biscayne Bay National Park, geysers are a specific portion of Yellowstone National Park).

-links (3) & (4) must contain information about your park but do not have to be park specific.

-link (5) must be hyperlinked to a search engine (of your choice, i.e. google, clusty, or dogpile) and be targeted to open in a new window.

Links/Pages 2, 3, 4 must have at least 3 thumbnailed images and 2 paragraphs that reflect the desired theme of the page (at least 9 total images and 6 paragraphs – 1 paragraph has at least 5 sentences). You are also required to give credit for all borrowed media and text.

Upon completion of this project you will be required to load your page on the computer with the projector attached to it and demonstrate how to navigate your page (in front of the entire class) and answer any questions about your page or park.
