Website Instructions

You will choose a Philosopher that you do not have much knowledge about and begin to find/save information and photos about that person. **Make sure that you find out what is unique about your chosen Philosopher and what sets apart from other Philosophers.**

Create a new folder titled, "the name of the philosopher that you have chosen" inside of your network folder. Here is an example of possible folder title, "**John Locke**".

Now you will begin creating a frames page about your chosen Philosopher. First, you must have a plan or outline. You are required to have preplanned your site and show this physical evidence with actual storyboards of your site and its layout. Also, you must have at least 4 hyperlinks, 3 of which must be done as follows:

-link (1) will be HOME and will be the introductory page of your website.

-link (2) will be specific to your Philosopher (i.e. John Locke – "Father of Liberalism" | Zeno of Citium – "Founder of the Stoic school of philosophy").

-links (3) & (4) must contain information about your Philosopher; the focus and content of these 2 pages will your decision – try to be cohesive.

Links/Pages 2, 3, 4 must have at least 3 thumbnailed images and 2 paragraphs that reflect the desired theme of the page (at least 9 total images and 6 paragraphs – 1 paragraph has at least 5 sentences). You are also required to give credit for all borrowed media and text.

Sometimes websites can be confusing and I want you to be very organized so that you will not find this lesson difficult. You will be required to name/title your various pages a particular way so that the web page will function properly. Incorrect titling of web pages will cause points to be taken off your grade.

Upon completion of this project you will be required to load your page on the computer with the projector attached to it and demonstrate how to navigate your page (in front of the entire class) and answer any questions about your page or Philosopher.
