Summer Site

Your assignment is to build a 4 page website (the theme of this site is what you did over the summer). You will have an opening/starting page, "index.htm" that will contain a brief written summary of your summer and have links to your 3 subtopics (additional pages). Your summer site will be graded according to the following requirements. Your assignment/website must be uploaded to your OneDrive folder for this class when it is due to be graded.

Examples of possible site sub-topics:

- Vacation, any time you left town
- Athletic activity, Church activity, Club, Family reunion
 - Work, visit from family or friend, new pet
 - Award, new computer, baby brother or sister

The following must be completed before your Summer Site Website will be graded:

- A new folder titled, "SummerSite_YourName". (no spaces in the folder name)
- All web pages and all information contained in your website, must be saved in your Onedrive folder titled "SummerSite_YourName". (no spaces in the folder name)
- The starting page for your site must have the file name "index.htm".
